

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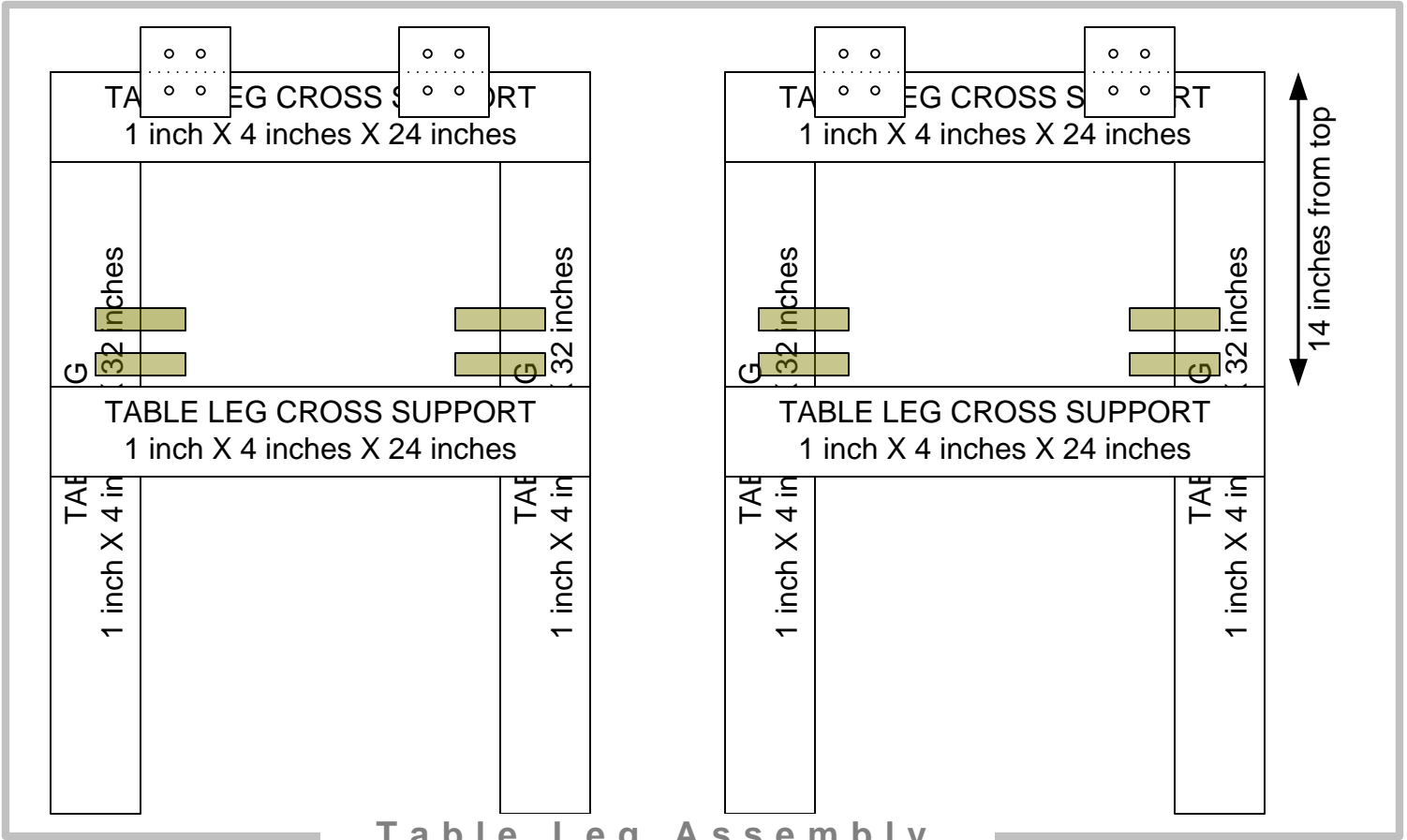
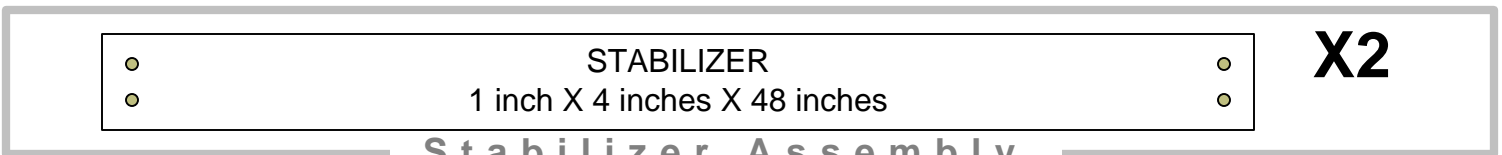


Table Leg Assembly

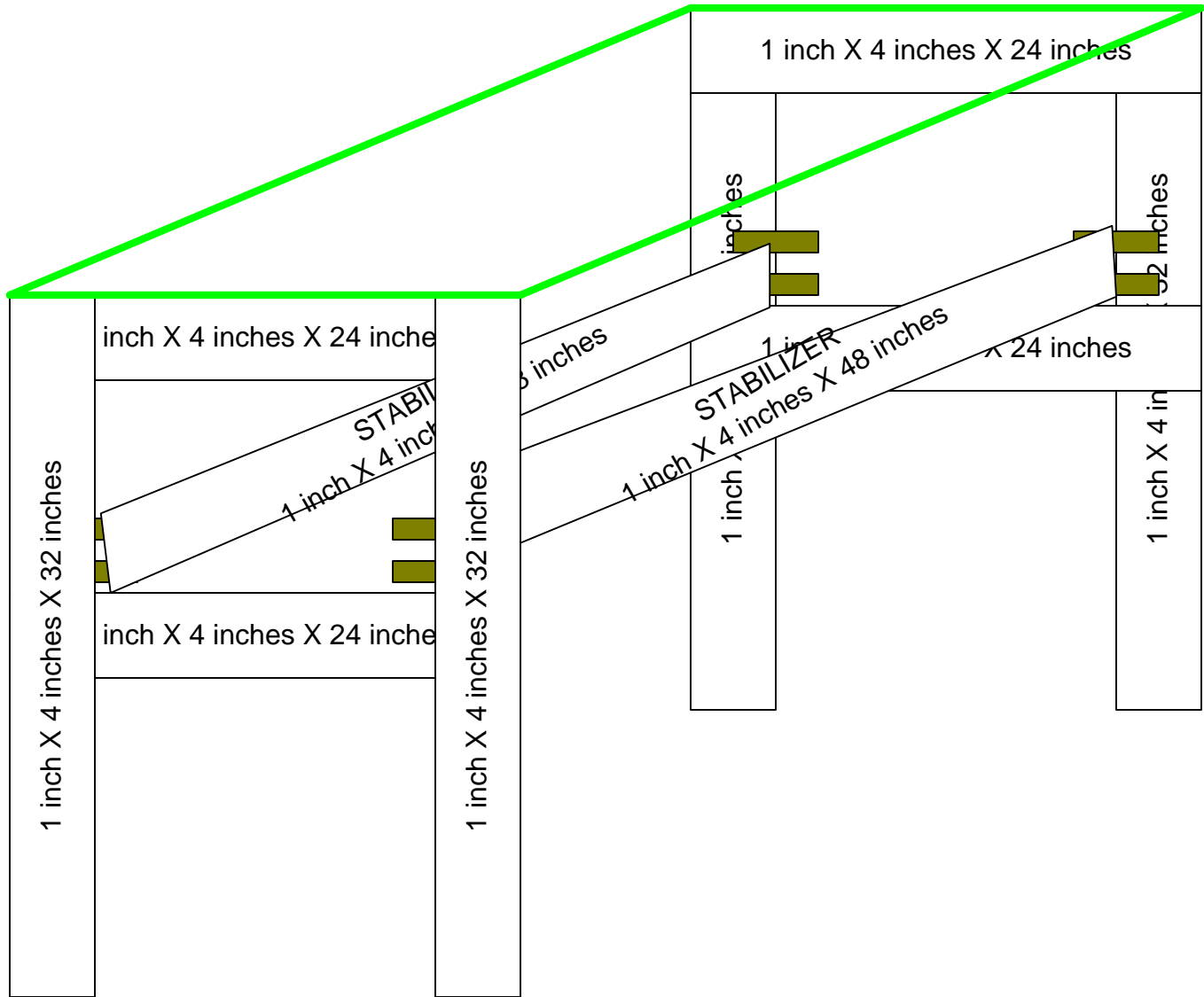


Stabilizer Assembly

1. Sand then paint table top green.
2. Build table legs as shown. Use at least two wood screws at each joint.
3. Sand then paint legs and stabilizers yellow.
4. Attach table leg assembly to tabletop with cross-supports facing in. Attach using hinges connecting top cross-support to underside of table. Make sure that when legs are folded out that the leg corner is flush with tabletop corner.
5. Clamp stabilizers to legs by setting each one upright on the inside of the legs resting on the lower cross-supports. Drill two ¼ inch holes through the stabilizers and 1 inch into the leg long ways. Holes must be drilled at the exact same points on each end of stabilizer.
6. Remove clamp and stabilizers. Insert 2 inch dowels with glue into the 1 inch hole that was drilled into the legs.



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SET UP

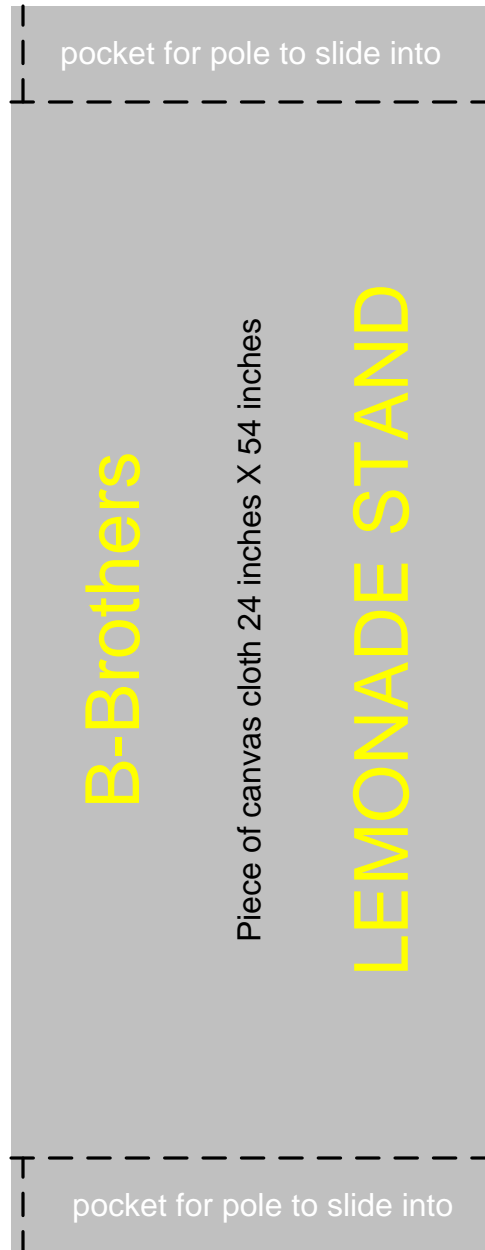
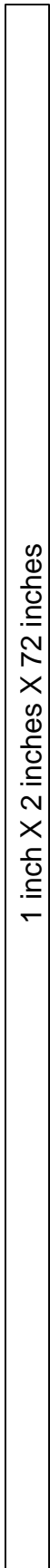
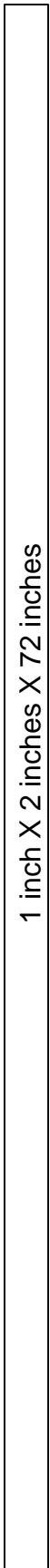
1. Fold table legs out. Hinges should be installed so that legs will not be able to fold out past 90 degrees.
2. Gently place stabilizers on lower cross-supports against the inside of the legs so the dowels slide into the holes. This will prevent the table from collapsing while it is being used.

STORAGE

1. Remove stabilizers then fold in legs flat.
2. Lay stabilizers on top of folded legs and attach using Velcro straps



LEMONADE STAND DESIGN



1. Sand 20 inches on one end of each 1"x2" pole so that end of pole is smooth for cloth to slide over it.

2. Paint poles yellow.

3. Fold 1 inch over on 54 inch sides of banner and hem. Hem by sewing or use iron-on stitching. This is to prevent future fraying.

4. Fold 2 ½ inches in on 24 inch sides and sew to create a pocket for the pole to slide into. Pin and test this with pole before sewing.

5. Paint your logo and "Lemonade Stand" on banner.

6. To attach banner to the stand, slide poles into pockets of banner. Stand up poles on each side of table against legs. Use 2 Velcro straps on each pole to secure to the leg.

CAUTION: On windy days, using the banner assembly will cause the table to blow over and upset all of your profits. If wind is blowing, either hang the banner on the front of the table or weight down the table with a very heavy object.
